

## How to get to Ferrara

### By Plane

#### **BOLOGNA - G. MARCONI AIRPORT**

Distance from Ferrara: 52 km

BUS&FLY Shuttle to FERRARA, 60 min. journey, daily scheduled departures every 2 h 30'. Shuttle bus every 20 minutes to Bologna Centrale railway station, and from there direct trains to Ferrara every hour.

#### **VENEZIA (Venice) – MARCO POLO AIRPORT**

Distance from Ferrara: 120 km

Shuttle bus every 20 minutes to Venezia Mestre railway station, and from there direct trains to Ferrara every hour. Average journey time (excluding shuttle bus): 1 hour 30 minutes.

#### **VERONA – VALERIO CATULLO AIRPORT**

Distance from Ferrara: 100 km.

Shuttle bus every 20 minutes to Verona railway station, and from there trains to Ferrara (changing at Padova). Average journey time (excluding shuttle bus): 2 hours 15 minutes.

Railway station: Ferrara Station

Ferrara Station is the principal station for the city and the province. It is served by the Bologna-Padova line. There are direct trains to Rovigo, Padova, Venezia (Venice), Bologna, Firenze (Florence), Roma (Rome), Napoli (Naples), Pescara and Vienna.

The station is connected by a pedestrian subway to the Via del Lavoro carpark (285 spaces) and to the West Terminal of the Bus Station.

Terminus for city bus lines 1 - 2 - 3C - 4C - 9 – 21.

## By Car

The **A13 Bologna-Padova** Autostrada (motorway or highway) with its 'Ferrara Nord' and 'Ferrara Sud' exits.

The A13 is connected to the A1 Milano-Napoli route which in turn connects to all the major roads in northern Italy: the A21 Torino to Piacenza, A22 Brennero to Modena, A15 La Spezia to Parma, and the A14 Bologna to Taranto.

### Parkings

The center of Ferrara is served by 3 major parkings and several minor parkings, see map below.

Parkings 2 and 3 are the nearest to the Conference venue.
