PRESENTATION

Caen National University is the promoter of the eleventh Joint Seminar on Geo-Environmental Engineering GEE 2012 in Caen, France, in collaboration with the Centre Français du Littoral and Paralia (registration and editorial management), the ESITC Engineering School of Caen and the territorial and industrial partners (local organization committee).

This conference follows up the tenth Japan-Korea-France-Canada Joint Seminar on Geo-Environmental Engineering held in Kagawa National College of Technology, Takamatsu (Japan) in 2011 planned by the GEE organizers, but with a stress on corporation activity and intended for all countries.

This two and half days GEE 2012 Conference comprises the May, 29th as welcome day for GEE organizers, one day of conference (May, 30th) work including oral presentations and posters in parallel sessions and finally the May 31st, dedicated to technical visits bearing on important geo-environmental engineering projects including a round trip on a French recent and touristic maritime engineering project.

The goals of this GEE 2012 Conference, are:

- up-to-date knowledge acquisition as far as geo-environmental engineering in the world is concerned;
- allowing exchange of ideas between specialists on concerned subjects;
- promoting comparison of analyses and experience between researchers and public and private sectors;
- presenting new material and techniques, together with the available documents (technical stands);
- developing Japan-Korea-France-Canada inter-university and inter-corporation collaborations.

CALL FOR PAPERS

- The official language is English.
- The paper, absolutely original, will be pre-selected by the **chairpersons of the organizing committee of GEE 2012 Conference**, (abstracts), followed by the review panel under the supervision of this committee (acceptance of the paper, corrections and choice of oral presentation or poster).
- Communications will be held either in the form of an oral presentation which will last 15 minutes including discussion, or as a poster presentation for 5 minutes. They will be collected in a book of communications, delivered at the conference. They will be available on line 8 days before the conference on the website <http://www.paralia.fr>.
- Some of the papers presented orally or as posters at the conference will be selected and proposed for publication in special issues of journals relative to the civil, coastal and geo-environmental engineering and management (list of journals will be given in the bulletin n°2).
- Special awards will be delivered to young researchers in different sessions on the topics outlined above.
- Authors are invited to indicate their preference for oral presentation or a poster.

REGISTRATION OF ABSTRACTS

The registration of the abstract of the communication proposed for the conference has to be submitted on line at <http://www.paralia.fr> by December 31st, 2011. The authors have to indicate the pertinent topics as listed above.

Papers should include: the title, the author(s) name(s) and a text from 4 to 8 pages. Writing of the manuscript should be formatted in strict accordance to the instructions to authors of the journal Revue Paralia available online at <http://www.paralia.fr>.

The acceptance of the papers will be communicated on April 1st, 2012.

The authors have to send back the final version of the accepted manuscripts before May 1st, 2012.
